

**Kiwanis Fair Parade
October 17, 2011**

The Fair Parade is scheduled for Monday, October 17th. All SBCPRD Soccer, Football, Cheerleading, and Swim Team Participants are encouraged to participate; however it is not mandatory.

Drop-Off

- **Participants should be dropped off between 4:00PM and 4:30PM.** All department participants will meet on Oak Street behind the Dairy Queen. Look for Recreation Department staff, vehicles, and trailers. Please drop off your children with their coach or SBCPRD staff.
- **SBCPRD staff will not be available until 4:00PM. Do not leave your child unattended.**
- NOTE: Oak, Olliff and Railroad Streets will be closed to non-parade traffic. We suggest you park in parking areas along Hwy 80 and walk to our position behind the Dairy Queen. **Please do not block the flow of traffic in the Dairy Queen parking lot.**

Pick- Up (Honey-Bowen Building/Fair Road)

- **In order for you to pick up your child in a timely manner, we recommend you park at or within walking distance of the Honey-Bowen Building before the parade starts.** Traffic during pick up will make it difficult to pick up your child on time.
- **Please arrive at the Honey-Bowen Building on Fair Road NO LATER than 5:30 pm to pick up your child!** For your child's safety please do not remove them from the parade route. Pick up your child in the back parking area (Senior Building Parking Lot) of the Honey-Bowen Building on Fair Road (turn right at the tennis courts). Coaches and SBCPRD staff will be responsible for participants until picked up by a parent.

Department policy regarding late pick-ups

Parents/guardians must pick up their child within 30 minutes after the scheduled pick up time (5:30PM). If no parent or emergency contact can be reached the program staff will contact the local authorities. Once the local authorities are involved the department staff will no longer be in charge of the situation.

Parade Route

We will follow the parade route from Oak Street to the Honey Bowen Building on Fair Road. The younger age groups (flag football, minor cheerleading, and soccer) will ride on the trailers. Older age groups will be walking the parade route. Please plan to have participants wear soccer or football jerseys, **no football pants, pads, or helmets**. Cheerleaders should wear their uniforms and bring their pom poms.
